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# Five Stories of Canmore

## 2018-2019 Program Details

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**Locations:** Canmore Museum and Canmore Civic Centre

**Approximate Schedule:**

- 15 Minute Introduction to Five Stories of Canmore and the museum
- 30 Minute scavenger hunt in the museum
- 45 Minute creation of Five Stories of Canmore collage

**Curriculum Connection:**

*Grade 1 Social Studies*

- appreciate how stories and events of the past connect their families and communities to the present:
- recognize how their families and communities might have been different in the past than they are today
- appreciate people who have contributed to their communities over time
- acknowledge and respect symbols of heritage and traditions in their family and communities
- In what ways has my community changed over time (e.g., original inhabitants, ancestors, generations, ways of life)?

**Purpose:**

To allow students to recognize that Canmore has changed over time by exploring different artifacts, stories, and images that past communities in Canmore have left behind.

**Detailed Activity Outline:**

*Introduction to Program*

- Welcome and Five Stories of Canmore introduction including a story and teaching collection artifacts for students to handle and share.

*Scavenger Hunt*

- Scavenger hunt in the museum, allowing students to discover more about each of the Five Stories of Canmore through the artifacts on display in the museum.

*Collage Making*

- Students get hands-on with images from the museum collection and mixed media materials to create a collage representing each of the Five Stories of Canmore. They will get to take the completed collage home with them at the end of the program.
