Canmore, AB | As part of their recent Canmore Museum Reimagined Strategy launched on 15 April 2021, the Canmore Museum was proud to announce they have been accepted into the OF/BY/FOR ALL Change Network, a global community of civic and cultural organizations working to welcome new communities and become more inclusive, equitable, and relevant.

The Change Network has 85 member organizations in 12 countries, including museums, libraries, theaters, chorale groups, and community centers. In this program, the Museum team will work with forward-thinking peers around the world to adopt new approaches to community work, build new skills, listen to their community, and respond with meaningful action and change. The Canmore Museum joins just seven other Canadian cultural organizations in the Of/By/For All Change Network, including the Royal Ontario Museum, the Winnipeg Ballet and the Ontario Science Centre

In joining the Change Network, Ron Ulrich, Executive Officer at the Canmore Museum states, “We are making a year-long commitment to make concrete changes to grow closer to our community. We believe our work will be strongest if more voices are involved and included as we grow. We invite you to share your ideas for what a more inclusive Canmore Museum might look like, get involved in our evolution, and hold us accountable to our commitments as we move forward.

Members of the Canmore Museum team meet each Monday with members of the Of/By/For All Change Network to learn more about the tools available to them which they can share with potential local partners to help build a stronger, more connected community through culture, heritage and place.
